

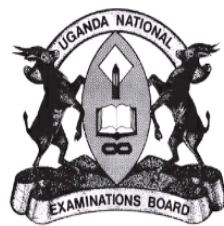

3. (a) Account for the betrayal of Jesus by Judas Iscariot in Mark's Gospel.
(b) Discuss lessons that Christians can learn from Jesus' betrayal.
4. (a) Discuss the significance of Jesus' transfiguration to his disciples.
(b) What lessons do Christians draw from the transfiguration?
5. To what extent were the Jewish religious leaders responsible for the death of Jesus on the cross in the Gospels of John and Mark?
6. (a) Account for the increasing hostility between Jesus and the Jewish religious leaders as portrayed in John.
(b) Give reasons for the conflicts among church leaders in Uganda today.
7. (a) Discuss the significance of Jesus' raising of Lazarus to life.
(b) Explain the church teaching about the resurrection of Believers.
8. "I am good Shepherd" John 10:11.
(a) Discuss the significance of this statement in John's Gospel.
(b) What lessons can the Christian church learn from the above statement?
9. How did Paul's response to the Lord's supper differ from the way the Corinthians celebrated it?
10. (a) Analyse Paul's response to the allegations made by the Judaizers in his letter to the Galatians.
(b) Identify and discuss areas in which modern preachers would face opposition from the Christians.
11. (a) Discuss the purpose for which the letter of James was written.
(b) Examine the relevance of James' teachings to Christians today.
12. Basing your answer on I Peter, explain how:
(a) believers should relate to their rulers and masters,
(b) wives and husbands should relate to each other
