Uses of animals to people.

- Some domestic animals give us food, manure, skin wool hooves.
- Some animals provide transport. eg horse, camel, and donkey.
- Some animals provide protection. eg dogs
- Some wild animals attract tourists
- Some wild animals act as taboos for some clans.

Dangers of animals.

- Some wild animals can eat people e.g. lions, leopard etc.
- Some old animals can eat domestic animals.
- Animals can eat crops.
