Adjectives can be ordered in an order named as N O P S H A C O M N

Number ( one, two, three, five hundred, etc)

Opinion ( nice, beautiful, ugly, unique, intelligent, etc )

P....( part of opinion )

Size/shape ( big, fat, small,

Age (new, old, young, )

Colour ( red, blue, white, grey, black etc )

Origin ( Ugandan, Eritrean, South Sudanese, Kenyan etc )

Material ( wooden, metallic, plastic, golden, silicon, woolen etc )

Noun ( girl, car, boy, shirt, woman, etc )

Examples.

1. Ogutu is fat. He is handsome. He is a journalist. He is from Uganda.

Ogutu is a handsome fat Ugandan journalist.

2. Harmella is a kind girl. She is from Eritrea. She is tall. She is brown.

Harmella is a kind tall brown Eritrean girl.
