COMPOSITION WRITING

There are various examples of compositions e.g. essays, poems, songs, letters, reports etc.

Writing Essays

A good essay must have the following qualities;

- i. Title
- ii. Introduction
- iii. Body
- iv. Conclusion
- v. Paragraphs

I. <u>Title</u>

- The title must be specific to what you're going to write about.
- It must be summarized in not more than six words.
- It must be either in capital letter or in title case e.g. THE ORPHAN BOY or The Orphan Boy

II. <u>Introduction</u>

- This could be a definition of what you're going to write about, an acknowledgement or a summary of the story you're to write is one sentence.
- It must prepare the reader of your story for the body e.g. On 2nd March 2020, I had my wonderful birthday party and this is how it was.

III. <u>Body</u>

- This is where every point of your story must be put.
- The points must be expressed in paragraphs and they must be well elaborated (they must be detailed)

• A paragraph is the space left between two different points/ sentences.

IV. Conclusion

- This serves as the general comment of the incident you've been talking about.
- We usually use words like;
 - > All in all,.....
 - > In a nutshell,.....
 - In conclusion,.....
- We can also write our conclusions in form of interjections e.g.
 - > What a wonderful journey it was!
 - > How hard that paper was!
 - > What a tragic accident that was!

<u>NOTE:</u> You should never waste time counting the words you've written and always base on what the instructions have told you write.

<u>A Sample of an Essay</u>

In about 150-200 words, write a composition about the accident you once saw. Talk about where you were going, what caused the accident, the number of people that died and how you felt about.

A TRAGIC ACCIDENT
