#### THURSDAY LESSON

GRAMMAR. USING : Either .....or.....

Either ....or..... is a conjunction used in sentences to show that one of the two will happen.

It can be used in two ways ie for beginning and within sentences

Examples.

1. Sarah will send a letter. Alex will send a letter.  
Either Sarah or Alex will send a letter.
2. The children are busy. The teachers are equally busy.  
Either the children or the teachers are busy
3. John will travel to Nairobi. John will travel to South Sudan  
John will travel to either Nairobi or South Sudan.
4. I shall clean the house. I shall clean the garage.  
I shall clean either the house or the garage.

USING: Neither.....nor.....

This is used in sentences to show that non of the two will happen. It is the opposite of either ....or....

Examples.

1. Cows don't eat grass Goats don't eat grass.

Neither cows nor goats eat grass.

2. The boys didn't sweep the class. The girls didn't sweep the class.

Neither the boys nor the girls swept the class

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3. My mother didn't cook chips. My mother didn't cook chicken.

My mother cooked neither chips nor chicken.

4. The teacher hasn't taught English. The teacher hasn't taught Science.

The teacher taught neither English nor Science.
