Other Bantu groups in Africa

The Eastern Bantu

They moved from Cameroon highlands and settled in Zambia. They then split into two groups. One group moved Northwards to Tanzania and Kenya.

Another group moved southwards and formed the southern Bantu.

Examples of tribes under the **Eastern Bantu** include:

The Akamba, Kikuyu, Nyamwezi and Taita.

Examples of **southern Bantu** include:

- Herero, Ovambo and Grigura in Namibia.
- Tswana in Botswana.
- The Shona in Zimbabwe
- The sotho in Lesotho
- The Swazi in Eswatini
- The Zulu, Xhosa, Ndebele and Vend in South Africa.

The Central Bantu

- Bemba and Lozi of Zambia.
- Bakongo, Balunda and Baluba of Congo.
- Yao and Makwa of Mozambique.
- Nyanja and Chewa of Malawi.
- Mbundu and Ovimbundu of Angola.
