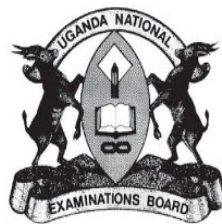

3. Account for the emergency of the coastal trading centres in East Africa during the early 19<sup>th</sup> century.

4. Explain the contribution of the cash crop economy to the social and economic development of Tanganyika during the colonial period.
5. Assess the impact of the development of modern industry on the social and economic development of Uganda during the colonial period.
6. Account for the low level of rural development in any one country of East Africa before independence.
7. Explain the contribution of the independent Churches to the social and economic development of Kenya during the colonial period.

8. Examine the strengths and weaknesses of the Ujamaa policy in Tanzania up to 1985.
9. Account for the collapse of the Co-operative Movement in Uganda after independence.
