FOREWORD

Following the Outbreak of the CoVID-19 Pandemic, Government of Uganda closed all schools and other educational institutions to minimize the spread of the coronavirus. This has affected more than 36,314 primary schools, 3129 secondary schools, 430,778 teachers and 12,777,390 learners.

The COVID-19 outbreak and subsequent closure of all has had drastically impacted on learning especially curriculum coverage, loss of interest in education and learner readiness in case schools open. This could result in massive rates of learner dropouts due to unwanted pregnancies and lack of school fees among others.

To mitigate the impact of the pandemic on the education system in Uganda, the Ministry of Education and Sports (MoES) constituted a Sector Response Taskforce (SRT) to strengthen the sector's preparedness and response measures. The SRT and National Curriculum Development Centre developed print Home- Study Materials, radio and television scripts for some selected subjects for all learners from Pre-Primary to Advanced level. The materials will enhance continued learning and learning for progression during this period of the lockdown, and will still be relevant when schools resume.

The materials focused on critical competences in all subjects in the curricula to enable the learners to achieve without the teachers' guidance. Therefore effort should be made for all learners to access and use these materials during the lockdown. Similarly, teachers are advised to get these materials in order to plan appropriately for further learning when schools resume, while parents/guardians need to ensure that their children access copies of these materials and use them appropriately.

I recognise the effort of National Curriculum Development Centre in responding to this emergency through appropriate guidance and the timely development of these home study materials. I recommend them for use by all learners during the lockdown.

KEY WORDS.

- Image of God: The picture through which the creator is seen to us
- Unique talent: Gifts given by God to individual that are not the same to all human beings
- Talents: Are God Given gifts
- Strengths and weakness,
- prayer

Introduction:

Each one of us is created uniquely. Uniqueness is the difference between you and another person. God created each of us with different talents which are also called gifts. Some gifting is seen easily while others are not seen easily.

Summary notices:

Key words;

Adolescents: It comes from Latina word "adolescere" which mean "growing up"."

Growth and development: growing from structural stage of life to another, E.g., from baby to boy or girl, man or woman.

Characteristics; examples of how something behaves

Introduction.

Each person grows from one stage of life to another. This growth and development stage in young people of (9 to 20 years) is called adolescent. Can you remember any body in your community or home who is an adolescent? How does the person behave?

Compare my examples with yours.

John is thirteen (13) years, he has deep voices, he likes to be with girls, his boy has grown big; he has deep voice and wide shoulder.

Summary notes.

Adolescent are boys and girls between the ages of (9 years to 20) years. The body parts of both boys and girls grow bigger. The girl's body becomes smooth and shapely. The voices of boys grow deeper the voices of girls become mellow soft and attractive the boys grow taller shoulders wider the girls grow hip, breasts develop. This stage is normal in all human being that God Created.

Introduction

In our homes and communities during (COVID 19) lockdown, there are many young people having problems because they are attractive, growing muscles, deep voices, breasts and hips.

Can you give some of the problems that you face because of your body changes? Compare your list with mine.

Many young girls are disturbed by big boys and men because of their attractive nature. Men always demand for sex from boys and girls. Some girls cry so easily because they are disturbed by boys. Some boys do not want to work.

Summary notes:

During the stage of adolescents, the girls and boys become unsettled, they like visiting people of opposite sex. Some begin to have sexual affair which can lead to spread of disease like (COVID 19), HIV/AIDS and some become pregnant. While the boys can be arrested by parents of the girls and taken to prison. The lockdown gives girls and boys of this stage a lot of free time to meet one another which can be misused.

What causes suffering in your homes community? What effects does suffering have on the people in your community and homes? Can you compare your list with mine?

Forms of suffering

Physical suffering. Can be in form of body pain, over thinking crying a lot sickness embracement in public shame, death of loved one.

Causes of suffering, Can be through beating by parent, brother or sister, diseases like (Covid 19), not going to school, early pregnancies that lead to drop out of schools, fighting at home between parents

Effects of suffering. Pain, Lose of income because of closer of business; lose of direction because of not going to school, running away from home because of parent beating. Loss of peace because of public shame.

Summary notes.

At homes, communities and in our selves we face many forms of suffering every day. These suffering are caused to us by our friends, because of disease like (COVID 19), the lockdown of our schools, business and bodabodas. Fighting in our home between ourselves and our parents. Because of suffering, fights and diseases, we lose our peace and our time we get ashamed in public. Sometimes we end up running away from home or killing one another.

Lepers: are people in the bible who hard long incurable sickness. They were not allowed to

mix freely with others. The can be related to COVID 19 patients.

Summary notes

Because of this, the friendship of peter and Jesus was restored, it created peace with in peter and it also prevented further sinning

Summary notes.

Jesus taught people how to be good in their homes and communities. He said people should love one another. Jesus loved his disciples. John (13:34,35). Jesus lived a selfless service without discrimination John (4.7;8), Jesus called justice for all, for that reason, we are to live a justice life. Jesus taught generosity to the needy, we therefore have to give to those in need during the COVID 19.

- Make friendships with other members of the family.
- Say a pray for a friend.

Material:

Brail, Exercise books, Pens, Time, Bible, Brain.

Key words:

Friendships; People you love and wish to receive support or give support to.

Introduction

How many people have you made friends with in your community and home? What is the importance of the friendships with these people that you have mentioned?

You can make comparison of your list with mine,

A Friend is for good reasons, people who will love and care for, give you advice and protect you from danger. If you are someone's friend you have to support them.

Summary notes:

Friendships are relationships between people who love, like and care for each other. Jesus taught that friends can also mean the love of God, John (15; 12), teaches that Jesus explained about the greatest commandments which is love He commands that everyone should love each other. Friends give good advices, to one another; they should be honest, respectful, peaceful loving and kind. During the (COVID 19), lockdown we need to make friend who can support us in our struggles. We also respect the friendship of others.

Key Word

Science: The study of physical or world of material things and the natural environment.

Technology: The making or use of tools and machines to do work. Examples radios and Computers, Telephones.

Education: The process of getting knowledge, skills, Values for use in life. Education starts from the time of conception and ends at the time of death. It is a lifelong experience.

Introduction:

Make a list of things that can be related as an example of science and technology that can be used to support education? Make comparison of such things with my list. Radio can be used during COVID 19 in teaching Children; Television is used to teach communities, Telephone is also used to teach children at home and at school.

Summary notes:

Science and technology is a very important thing in education. The material world and natural things need tools or materials to work. These examples like radio, television are used during COVID 19 to advance education. We study through radios and televisions. This enables us to learn even when schools are closed and we are at home. Science and technology improves transport in air water and roads it has improved communication in our communities. Compare your list with mine. Law, helps people to behave in an acceptable way, help to reduce conflicts, to guide on how we should treat other people and ensure adequate sharing of the World's resources.

Summary notes,

The laws are rulings that guide appropriate conduct in society. In the Old Testament, God gave the law to the Children of Israel to guide them. The Book of Deuteronomy is good example of the law. Deuteronomy Chapter 5; 16, 20, talks about the law. This can also be summaries in the Ten Commandment that we shared in Chapter one. These laws are still used even in COVID 19 Lockdown. Our country Uganda, has the law which we call our constitution. As you could remember in our social studies, we noted that the constitution of Uganda helps to guide the country on how we are to be governed. In our schools, there rules and regulations that guide our conduct at school for example: no child is to beat another. At home, there are also rules that help to guide a home. We have to obey these rules so that we do not get into problems. For example, at home we are required to obey our parents and respect one another. This helps us to live a happy and harmonious life.
