6. "The way the Palestinian issue has been handled by Muslim countries shows Arab nationalism in the guise of Islam". Assess the validity of this statement.

7. Examine the origins and contributions of Al-Moravids to Islam.

8. Account for the initial success and later failure of the Mahdist revolt.

9. To what extent did the Sokoto and Massina jihads transform West African societies in the 19th Century?

10. Analyze factors in, and challenges to the spread of Islam in Somalia.

11. Examine the low pace of Islamination process in the interior of East Africa, and possible ways of accelerating this pace.
