5. Analyse the use of parables in the Gospel of Mark and Discourses in the Gospel of John.
6. (a) Examine the significance of the cleansing to a modern christian.
 (b) Explain the relevance of this cleansing to a modern christian.
7. (a) Explain the meaning of the feeding of the five thousand in John's Gospel.
 (b) Discuss the relevance of this sign to the christian community today.
8. Analyse the role of women in Jesus' Ministry as depicted in John's Gospel.
