Changing sentences from affirmative to negative and to interrogative in the past simple tense

Examples

1. The police officers recovered some stolen guns.

The police officers didn't recover any stolen guns

Did the police officers recover any stolen guns?

2. Sheryl wrote a book about peace and security Sheryl did not write a book about peace and security. Did Sheryl write a book about peace and security?

Present Perfect Tense

This tense is used to talk about actions that happened after a particular time.

It is formed using has on singular and have on plural nouns plus the past participle of the verb

Examples:

- A] We have learnt about peace and security.
- B] Simon has reported the case to the police station.
- C] The army man has shot at an enemy.
- D] He has sworn never to steal again.
