## **HOW THE WORLD HELPED TO STOP APARTHEID IN SOUTH AFRICA.**

The OAU put sanctions on south Africa.

Many countries stopped relations with south Africa e.g. trade.

The commonwealth organization banned south Africa from the commonwealth games.

The OAU funded the ANC.

The United Nations forbade member states from supplying weapons to south Africa.

Frontline states trained freedom fighters.

NB: frontline states were African countries that helped in the fight against apartheid.

Frontline states included; Angola, Mozambique, Tanzania, Zimbabwe.

They funded freedom fighters.

They trained freedom fighters.

Julius Nyerere was the chairperson of the frontline states.

And the headquarter of the frontline states was in Tanzania because it was the farthest independent country from south Africa.
