Learn the meaning of these vocabulary

bobbin: a small device in a sewing machine on which a thread is wound.

seam: a line where two edges meet and are sewn together.

button hole: a hole on a pieces of clothing for a button.

design: the general arrangement of different parts of something made

garment: a piece of clothing

seamstress: a woman who sews and makes clothes

patch: a small piece of cloth used to cover a hole in a cloth, to is cover a hole using another cloth.

stitch: To use a needle and thread to join, decorate or repair pieces of cloth.

sewing machine: a machine that is used for sewing things that are made out

scissors a tool for cutting a cloth or paper that has two sharp blades

thimble :a small metal or plastic object worn on the end of fingers to protect them.

hem: to fold and sew the cloth edge.

thread:a thin string of cotton, wool or silk used for sewing garmentstape measure: a long narrow strip of plastic or cloth marked with measurementsweave:to form by interlacing long threads passing in one direction with others at a right to them.

dress:a one-piece garment worn by women and girls that covers the body and extends down over the legs or to put one's clothes.
