Possessive Pronouns

A pronoun is a word that represents a noun.

A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that expresses ownership of a thing or a person.

Possessive pronouns respond to the question of Whose?

Examples of possessive pronouns

- 1. Whose? mine
- 2. Whose? yours
- 3. Whose? hers
- 4. Whose? his
- 5. Whose? ours
- 6. Whose? theirs
- 7. Whose? its
