Possessive Pronouns

A pronoun is a word that represents a noun.

A possessive pronoun is a pronoun that expresses ownership of a thing or a person.

Possessive pronouns respond to the question of **Whose?**

Examples of possessive pronouns

1. Whose? mine
2. Whose? yours
3. Whose? hers
4. Whose? his
5. Whose? ours
6. Whose? theirs
7. Whose? its
