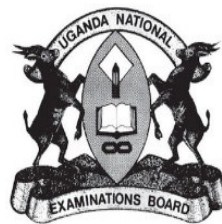

6. Assess the achievements of the commonwealth of independent states (CIS) since 1991.

SECTION C: AFRICA AND THE MIDDLE EAST.

7. Account for the rise of Maumar Gadaffi to power in Libya in 1969.
8. To what extent was John Okello responsible for the outbreak of the 1964 Zanzibar revolution.
9. Account for the defeat of the Arabs during the 1948-1949 Arab - Israel war.
10. Discuss the problems faced by the Arab League since 1945.

SECTION D: SOUTHERN ASIA AND THE FAR EAST.

11. Assess the impact of the 1951 San Francisco treaty on the political, social and economic developments in Japan.
12. How successful was Jawaharlal Nehru's domestic policy in India?
13. To what extent has the Colombo plan contribute to the social and economic development of Southern Asia and the far East?

SECTION E: EUROPE (EXCLUDING CIS)

14. "Germany's strategic miscalculations were primarily responsible for the defeat of the Axis powers during World War II". Discuss.
15. Account for the return of General Charles de Gaulle to power in France in 1958.
16. Assess the impact of the cold war on Europe between 1945 and 1990.

SECTION F: GENERAL

17. Examine the challenges faced by the United Nations organization (UNO) since 1945.
18. Assess the achievements of the North Atlantic Treaty Organization (NATO) since 1949.
