8. Discuss the obstacles created by slave trade in the Islamisation of West Africa.
9. Examine the expansion and growth of Mali Empire under Muslim rulers.
10. Explain the contribution of Askia Muhammad Toure to the spread of Islam in Songhai Empire.
11. (a) Account for the Sokoto Jihad.  
(b) How was the state that was established after the Jihad administered?
12. To what extent was Samori Toure's resistance to colonial rule successful?
