Monday Lesson.

Grammar: Use oftooto.....within sentences.

This is a conjunction used to join sentences with a, negative idea therefore, we don't need to use " **not** " in the same sentence.

Note: When using ...too ..to.., the pronoun at the end of the second sentence should be dropped eg;

Nathan is very lazy. I cannot help **him** .

Nathan is too lazy for me to help. (Pronoun **him** is dropped)

Other Examples.

1. That lady is very fat. She cannot run.

That lady is too fat to run.

2. John is unsteady. He cannot pass the examination.

John is too unsteady to pass the examination.

3. It is very hot. We cannot walk for an hour.

It is too hot for us to walk for an hour.

Grammar: Using:....such a/an.....that......

This conjunction is equally used to join sentences that are related.

Articles a and **an** are used before an adjective in the first clause of the sentence.

Examples

1. Corona is a very dangerous disease. It forced everyone in the world to stay at home.

Corona is **such** a dangerous disease that it forced everyone in the world to stay at home.

2. Peter is a very tall gentleman. He can pick mangos from the tree.

Peter is such a tall gentleman that he can pick mangoes from the tree.

3. This is a very easy test. Everyone will pass it.

This is such an easy test that everyone will pass.
