<u>If 1.</u>

Conditional sentences are sentences with a condition that must be full filled before one gets the results. In if 1, there is a possibility of something happening if the given condition is full filled.

NOTE: In if 1, the present simple tense + future simple tense are used in sentences.

If can be used in two ways ie for beginning sentences and within the sentences.

Examples.

- 1. If Abigail works hard, she will perform well.
- 2. The children will have lunch if they complete their work.
- 3. My father will take us out if he gets enough money.
- 4. If my mother comes back early, she will prepare for us a delicious meal.
