3. "What therefore God has put together, let not man put a sunder". (Mark 10:9).  
(a) Discuss Mark's teaching on marriage and divorce in view of the above statement.  
(b) Compare Mark's teaching with that of the Old Testament.
4. (a) From your knowledge of Mark's Gospel, discuss the extent to which Jesus respected (obeyed) the Jewish law.  
(b) When many Christians disobey the church leaders in Uganda today?
5. (a) Discuss the meaning of the transfiguration of Jesus to his disciples.  
(b) What is the relevance of this event to Christians today?
6. Examine the importance of the prologue of John's Gospel (1:1-18) to the rest of the Gospel.
7. (a) Analyse John's teachings on the Holy spirit.  
(b) In what ways have Christians in Uganda today limited the working of the Holy spirit in the church?
8. (a) "Mark and John portray Peter as the leader of the disciples". Justify this statement.  
(b) What lessons can Christian leaders learn from Peter?
9. Analyse Paul's teaching concerning Christian freedom in the letter to the Galatians.
10. (a) Examine Paul's teaching that patience and prayer are important in Christian living.  
(b) Discuss the lessons Christians can learn from this teaching.
11. (a) Examine James' teaching that patience and prayer are important in Christian living.  
(b) How is this teaching relevant to the church today?
12. To what extent is 1<sup>st</sup> Peter's letter about suffering?
