2. (a) Many scholars believe that the Gospel of Mark was written first. Account for this belief.
(b) Examine the processes through which the Gospels were written.
3. (a) Examine the ways in which the Early church conducted worship.
(b) Compare and contrast those ways with the ways in which Christians in Uganda conduct worship today.
4. How does the Gospel of Mark show that:
(a) the kingdom of God has come,
(b) the kingdom of God is a future reality?
5. (a) "In spite of being convicted, Jesus was not guilty". Basing your argument on Mark's Gospel, justify this statement.
(b) What lessons do modern courts of law learn from Jesus' trial?
6. Account for Jesus' crucifixion on the cross in the Gospels of Mark and John.
7. "Let him who is without sin among you be the first to throw a stone at her". John 8:7 RSV.
(a) Examine the significance of this suggestion by Jesus Christ.
(b) How can the clergy apply this in their services to Christians?
8. (a) Discuss the significance of the washing of the feet of the disciples by Jesus.
(b) How can the clergy apply this in their services to Christians?
9. "Hand this man over to Satan so that his sinful nature may be destroyed and his spirit saved on the day of the Lord". I Cor. 5:5 RSV.
(a) Examine the circumstances which made Paul say this to the Corinthians.
(b) What message does this story have for christian communities today?
10. Analyse how Paul, in his epistle to the Galatians, uses the Old Testament illustrations to support the idea that the Law cannot put man right with God.

11. Discuss the responsibilities Peter assigns to the following groups of believers :

(a) the chosen race (brethren),

(b) Slaves,

(c) Wives (I Ptr 2:11-37).

12. (a) Analyse the teaching of James about the dangers of wealth.

(b) How can this teaching on wealth help rich Christians in Uganda to live a proper christian life?
