5. (a) Discuss the Marxist teaching about work.
(b) Compare it with the christian teaching about work.
6. (a) Analyse the dangers of commercializing the leisure activities in Uganda today.
(b) What is the christian teaching on leisure?
7. (a) Discuss the use of drugs and alcohol in African tradition.
(b) Examine the effects of misuse of drugs and alcohol.
8. (a) Compare the traditional African understanding of wealth with that of the modern society.
(b) Suggest ways in which wealth may be used profitably by Christians.

LAW AND ORDER

9. "Capital punishment (death penalty) is a necessity in society". Assess the validity of this statement.
10. (a) "The police is responsible for the increase of crime in Uganda". Assess the validity of this allegation.
