6. (a) Analyse the role of women in Jesus' ministry in the Gospels of Mark and John.
(b) Discuss the contribution of women in the spread of the Gospel in Uganda today.

(b) Examine the wrong things in the church today that may require cleansing.

10. (a) Account for the conflicts between Paul and the Judaizers in his letter to the Galatians.
(b) What lessons can modern Christians learn about Paul's defense of his apostleship?
11. (a) Analyse Peter's teaching on the way wives and husbands should relate to each other.
(b) What is the significance of his teaching to married couples?

12. (a) Discuss James' teaching on the control of the tongues.
