SECTION A

1. Describe the social and economic organization of the Kikuyu during the early 19th century.
2. To what extent did the land tenure system and exploitation of natural resources contribute to the growth of the Buganda kingdom during the early 19th century?
3. Describe the system of trade between the interior and coastal peoples of East Africa during the first half of the 19th century.

SECTION B

4. Assess the impact of the 1900 Buganda Agreement on the people of Uganda.
5. Examine the contribution of African labour to the economic and social development of East Africa during the colonial period.
6. Assess the impact of the African Independent Church Movement on the people of Tanganyika during the colonial period.
7. Account for the differential rural development in Kenya during the colonial rule.

SECTION C

8. Assess the impact of the Asian domination of the economy on the peoples of any one country in East Africa after independence.
9. Examine the role played by the international donor community in the economic development of Tanzania since 1980.
10. Assess the impact of the breakup of the East African Community (EAC) in 1977 on the economic and social developments in the member states.
