SUBTOPIC: Conditional sentences.

Conditional sentences are sentences that express an action being done under a certain condition.

Conditional sentences are divided into three ie

- 1. conditional one (if 1)
- 2. conditional two (if 2)
- 3. conditional three (if 3)

If 1

If 1 or conditional one is used when we want to express that something will happen if a certain condition is fulfilled e.g.

- 1. If I get money, I will buy an envelope.
- 2. If mummy comes back from work, she will prepare chapatti for us.
- 3. Tom will perform well if he works hard.

Note:

- 1. A conditional sentence has got two parts namely **if clause** and **main clause**
- 2. In if 1, we use the present simple tense in the if clause and future simple tense in the main clause.
- 3. When an if clause begins a sentence, a comma follows. If it comes last, there is no need for a comma

Grammar: Conditional sentences.

Using: Unless......

Unless simply means **if not** .

It carries a negative idea if - not

Unless can be used in two ways ie

-for beginning sentences.

While using **Unless** for beginning sentences, a comma must be put within a sentence to separate the two clauses.

-within a sentence

While using unless within a sentence, a comma isn't applied.

Examples

(Using unless within sentences)

- 1. Your letter will not be posted if you don't put a stamp on it.
- -Your letter will not be posted **unless** you put a stamp on it.
- 2. Boys will not enter the class if they do not tuck in their shirts.
- -Boys will not enter the class **unless** they tuck in their shirts.
- 3. The message will not reach her father if she doesn't send a telegram.

The message will not reach her father **unless** she sends a telegram

- 4. Most pupils will not sit for examination if they do not pay school fees n time.
- -Most pupils will not sit for their examination **unless** they pay school fees in time.

Grammar: Conditional Sentences.

(Using unless while beginning sentences)

Note: While beginning sentences using Unless, a comma must be used to separate the two clauses.

Examples

- 1. If the driver does not drive well, he will get an accident.
- -Unless the driver drives well, he will get an accident.
- 2. If people do not work hard, poverty will continue to prevail.
- -Unless people work hard, poverty will continue to prevail.
- 3. If he doesn't have a mask, he will not enter our home.
- -Unless he has a mask, he will not enter our home.
- 4. If that dog is not tied, it will bite someone today.
- -Unless that dog is tied, it will bite someone today.
