Tuesday Lesson: Grammar.

The Past Perfect Tense.

This tense is used to describe actions that happened before a particular time.

The helping verb "had" before the main verb in its past perfect tense are used. " Had" is derived from "has" and "have".

Examples

- 1. He had gone to church.
- 2. They had borrowed a lot of money.
- 3. Nakachwa had finished her homework before she went for swimming.
- 4. The mad dog had bitten him last night.

Peter had not finished his home work by six o'clock.

Had Peter finished his home work by six o'clock?

3. They had woven baskets before the display.

They had not woven baskets before the display.

Had they woven the baskets before the display?
