Lesson 1: English, Grammar.

THE FUTURE SIMPLE TENSE

This tense is used when thinking or imagining of an action that will take place in the future.

When using this tense, two helping verbs are used with specific pronouns and nouns ie

He,she, they, it, you with singular and plural nouns $\,$ are used with " will " $\,$ We , I are used with " shall " $\,$

Examples

- 1. We shall travel to the village tomorrow.
- 2. Mike will play football later.
- 3. Sarah and Alice will cook food when mummy comes back.
- 4. I shall visit you next week.

Lesson; grammar

Affirmative , negative and interrogative sentences in the future simple tense. Examples.

- 1. We shall travel to the village tomorrow. We shall not travel to the village tomorrow. Shall we travel to the village tomorrow?
- 2. Mike will play football later.

Mike will not play football later.

Will mike play football later?

Friday, 22nd January 2021.

Grammar. Question tags in the future simple tense.

A question tag is a short question found at the end of the statement. It is used to check the correctness of the statement.

When using question tags, a comma must be used to separate the statement from the question tag.

NB. When the statement is positive, the question tag will be negative and when the statement is negative, the question tag will be positive.

Examples.

- 1. Anna will wait for you, wont she?
- 2. Abigail will prepare breakfast tomorrow, wont she?
- 3. We shall not visit our grandparents tomorrow, shall we?
- 4. I shall eat all the fruits before bathing, shan't I?
