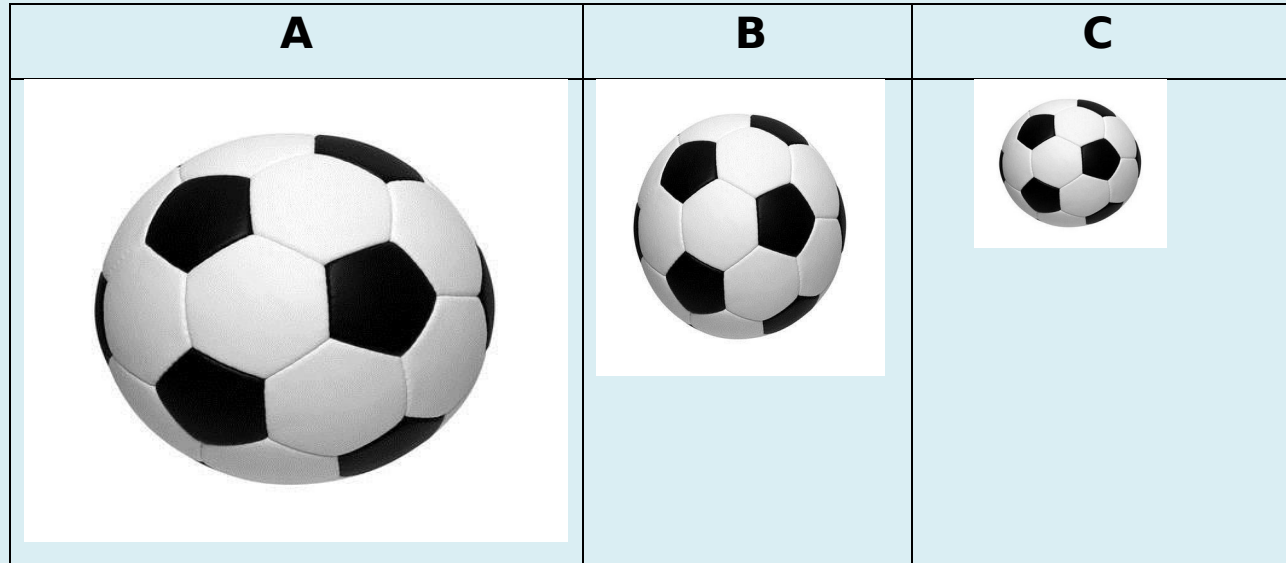
**CONTENT: COMPARING, DESCRIBING WORDS.**
