Monday Lesson: Grammar.

Using:.....and neither.....

Examples.

1. Ruth did not pay for the tour. Doreen did not pay for the tour. Ruth did not pay for the tour and neither did Doreen.

- 2. Alex is not available on MTN. Vivian is not available on MTN Alex is not available on MTN and neither is Vivian.
- 3. The children are not watching the news. Their parents are not watching the news. The children are not watching the news and neither are their parents.

4. Ann doesn't have enough money in her bag. Ednah doesn't have enough money in her bag. Ann doesn't have enough money in her bag and neither does Ednah.

Tuesday Lesson.

Grammar: Using:.....and so.....

This structure is only used in a affirmative.

Examples.

1. Ruth paid for the tour. Melat paid for the tour. **Ruth paid for the tour and so did Melat.**

- 2. Monday was very windy. Friday was equally very windy. Monday was very windy and so was Friday.
- 3. The boys will eat all the food in ten minutes. The girls will also eat all the food in ten minutes. **The boys will eat all the food in ten minutes and will the girls.**

Thursday Lesson.

The past continuous tense

This tense is used to show that an action was taking place in the past and still going on.

Was and were are used as helping verbs +ing

(Using: While, When, As in the past continuous tense) **Examples.**

1. As Miya was cooking food, Jerimiah was sweeping the compound.

2. While the teacher was teaching, the children were listening attentively

3. As he was grazing animals, his father was having lunch.

4. While it was raining heavily, the stubborn boys were playing football.

Note: more examples

5. Recheal was cooking food.

6 .Jomo and Adonay were busy drawing cartoons yesterday.

Changing sentences from affirmative, to negative and to interrogative in the past continuous tense

Examples.

 She was picking some fruits.
<u>She was not picking any fruits.</u> Was she picking any fruits?

Were the boys helping the headsman to spray the animals?
