The past tense is used when on actions that started and ended at a definite time in the past .It is a verb tense that talks about things that happened or existed before now. It shows that you are talking about something that already happened.

Examples

Verbs that form the past tense by adding “ d” or “ed”.

Present tense	Past tense
wait	waited
spray	sprayed
provide	provided
prove	proved
push	pushed
play	played
dance	danced
touch	touched
treat	treated
report	reported
wash	washed
use	used
move	moved

Examples

copy	copied
try	tried
envy	envied
dry	dried
fry	fried
cry	cried
dirty	dirtied
hurry	hurried
worry	worried

THE PAST TENSE OF THE IRREGULAR VERBS

An irregular verb is one which does not form the past tense by adding “ d “ or “ ed “ .

Examples

is	was / were
keep	kept
bring	brought
buy	bought
break	broke
eat	ate
come	came
do	went
dig	dug
blow	blew
make	made
fall	fell

some examples of irregular verbs that do not change.

present tense	past tense
cut	cut
cut	put
cost	cost
hit	hit
hurt	hurt
shut	shut
