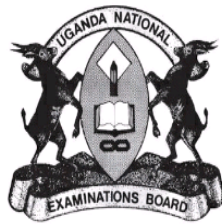

5. (a) Discuss the factors that make work uninteresting for some people in Uganda today.
(b) Suggest Christian principles that can make work more fulfilling for such people.
6. (a) Examine the causes of unemployment in Uganda today.
(b) How can the church help in reducing the problem of unemployment?
7. (a) Account for the high rate of drug addiction in urban areas of Uganda.
(b) Discuss the dangers of drug addiction in Uganda today.
8. (a) "Foreign Aid is a benefit to the rich countries but not the poor countries". Comment on this statement.
(b) As a Christian, discuss the type of Foreign Aid which would be suitable for your country.

9. Discuss the advantages and disadvantages of imprisonment of criminals in Uganda today.
