Examples.

1. Sheryl cooked food yesterday.

Sheryl didn't cook food yesterday.

Did Sheryl cook food yesterday?

2 The children cleaned the whole compound alone.

The children didn't clean the whole compound alone.

Did the children clean the whole compound alone?

Tuesday Lesson: Grammar.

The active and Passive voices in the past simple tense.

In active voice, we begin our sentences with the doer/ subject of the action.

In passive voice, we begin our sentences with the object.

Note:was/were + the verb in the past participle are used in the passive voice.

Examples.

1. Ada prepared very delicious food.

Very delicious food was prepared by Ada.

2. All the boys slashed the compound in an hour last weekend.

The compound was slashed by all th boys in an hour last week.

3. That boy burst all our balls during the game yesterday.

All our balls were burst by that boy during the game yesterday.
